



Motive-Action Apprenticeship Admission Scholarship

The Motive-Action Apprenticeship Admission Scholarship (MAAS) is a financial award which is presented to Motive-Action graduates who are successful in getting “signed up” to begin a recognized trade apprenticeship in the Province of Alberta.

Who can apply?

Any Motive-Action graduate may apply.

To qualify you must be a Motive-Action graduate and registered apprentice who has paid tuition for a first year apprenticeship program in a recognized trade within the previous 12 months.

The applicant should demonstrate financial need on the application form.

Scholarships Available

The MAAS is valued at \$500. More than one MAAS may be awarded in the calendar year. A graduate may only qualify for one award.

To Apply:

Acquire an application by 1) Downloading the MAAS application from the Motive-Action website, 2) Calling Motive-Action and having it mailed to you, or 3) Picking up a blank application at Motive-Action.

Complete your application (pages 2, 3, and 4 of this document), and provide a copy of your first year’s school tuition payment receipt.
